Advisory for Indians living in Iceland

Embassy of India in Reykjavik requests the Indian nationals living in Iceland to consider giving priority to their registration with the Embassy through the official website portal link (<https://www.indianembassyreykjavik.gov.in/register.php>) with all necessary information, which comes useful in rendering prompt assistance to Indian nationals in distress or in extraordinary circumstances, besides timely redressal of grievances. Such information is useful for sharing important announcements.

The External Affairs Ministry has launched the Global Pravasi Rishta portal and app to connect with the over 30 million strong Indian Diaspora across the world. It aims to create a three-way communication between the Ministry, Indian Missions and the diaspora. This portal is created to facilitate the Indian Diaspora members, i.e., NRIs, PIOs and the OCIs by connecting them to various new and existing government schemes benefiting them in various areas of interest and also facilitate the Indian government to connect with the overseas Indian community. The Embassy of India in Reykjavik requests Indian diaspora to create an account on <https://pravasirishta.gov.in/home>.

Indian students are also requested to register themselves on the MADAD portal (https://portal2.madad.gov.in/AppConsular/user/RegistrationBaseAction?request_locale=en) with their full details like passport, course, university, institutions, address, email ids. This portal will also assist during any crises management and lend a helping hand to the students. It will also enable the students to reach the Embassy officers and services in time of emergencies.
